

stephieface's pocket pixie

pattern written by Stephieface/ Steph Conley

This pattern is a basic customizable pattern for a 7.5inch tall doll. Included in this pattern are directions to make a pair of underwear for the pixie should you wish to make some.



Materials:

Worsted weight yarn in desired "skin" color (1 skein of Red Heart was more than enough, I can still make a few more with the same skein.)

US3 DPNs

Tapestry needle (for weaving in ends and attaching limbs)

Stuffing (whatever works for you, polyfill, yarn scraps, etc)

-optional- worsted weight yarn or smaller in whatever color you want for "underwear" you will not need a lot at all.

-Note; These materials are for a *no face* doll. Should you want a face on your pixie, do whatever you like... beads, prefab toy eyes, embroidery, etc

Head/Body

R1: CO 6 sts on to one DPN, as with i-cord slide stitches to other end and knit

R2: move stitches around so that there are 2 on each needle which will already be joined in the round, K1, M1, K1 * repeat for each needle (ending with 9 sts)

R3: Knit

R4: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 * repeat each needle (15 sts)

R5: Knit

R6: Knit

R7: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1, M1, K1, M1, K1* repeat ea needle (27 sts) - you can weave in the CO end now if you like, it will be easier than later

R8: Knit

R9: Knit

R10: Knit

R11: K1, k2tog, K1, k2tog, K1, k2tog * repeat ea needle (18 sts)

R12: Knit

R13: Knit

R14: K1, k2tog * repeat for whole round (12 sts)

R15: Knit

R16: k2tog * repeat for whole round (6 sts, 2 ea DPN) [stuff pixie's head]

R17: Knit (neck)

R18: Knit (neck)

R19: K1, M1, K1 * repeat ea needle

R20: Knit

R21: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 * repeat ea needle

R22 - 31: Knit

R32: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 * repeat ea needle

R33: Knit

R34: Knit

R35: Knit

R36: k2tog, K3, k2tog * repeat ea needle

R37: k2tog, K1, K2tog * repeat ea needle

R38: k2tog, K1 * repeat ea needle

-optional row- R39: k2tog * repeat ea needle

(knitting this row will mean less stitches to draw through but also makes a wee bit of a point on what will be the “butt” of the pixie)

Stuff pixie’s body. Break yarn and draw string through remaining stitches and weave in ends

Arms (make 2)

CO 4 on one DPN

R1- 20: Knit as I-cord

[continuing as I-cord]

R21: K2, M1, K2

R22: Knit

R23: K2, Kfb, K2

R24: Knit

Break yarn and draw string through remaining stitches, weave in what would be BO end- leave the CO end alone, this will be used to attach arm to body. Flatten the non all I-cord end to make more hand-like. Using the CO tail attach arm to the pixie’s body. Do this for both arms.

Legs (make 2)

CO 6 on one DPN

R1-25: Knit as I-cord

[continuing as I-cord]

R26: K4, turn, P2, turn, K4 (this is making the pixie’s heel)

R27: Knit

R28: Knit

R29: Knit

R30: Knit

R31: Knit

R32: k2tog x 3 (3 sts remain)

Break yarn and draw through remaining stitches, pinch heel, using the BO tail whip stitch end of foot to look somewhat like toes, weave in end. Using CO tail, attach legs to pixie’s body. Do this for both legs.

Pocket Pixie Underwear (also uses US3

DPNs, used as straights)

with worsted weight (or smaller) yarn in whatever color you like...

CO 10

1x1 rib for 4 rows

R5: Knit

R6: Purl

R7: Knit

R8: Purl

R9: k2tog, K6, k2tog

R10: p2tog, P4, p2tog

R11: k2tog, K2, k2tog

R12: Purl

R13: Knit

R14: Purl

R15: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1

R16: P1, M1, P4, M1, P1

R17: K1, M1, K6, M1, K1

R18: Purl

R19: Knit

R20: Purl

R21: Knit

1x1 rib for 4 rows

BO

Fold in half and sew sides together, leaving openings for the legs. Weave in ends.
